# **Summer Tuition FAQ:**

# How do I pay for camp?

- •We only accept online payments through 1Core. Payments are due at the time of registration.
- •A \$35 NSF fee will apply to all returned payments.

# Are there refunds or credits given for absences?

•There are NO REFUNDS, CREDITS, DISCOUNTS OR MAKE-UP DAYS for absences - including COVID related closures/absences. Registration fees are non-refundable.

# What if I need to cancel or change my enrolled dates?

- •If you cancel prior to May 1, 2023, you will receive a refund of your payment to the original payment method, less a \$25 processing fee for each session you cancel.
- •If you cancel after May 1, 2023, you will receive a credit for each session you purchased, less a \$25 processing fee for each session you cancel, usable for any Rainbow Rising offering through August 16, 2024. A three-week notice prior to the start of the session is required for the cancellation credit to be applicable to your 1Core account.
- •A three-week notice must be given prior to the first day of your camp week for any cancellations or changes in schedules. Availability is not guaranteed for any added sessions.
- •Cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on the corresponding deadlines.
- •Registration fees are not eligible for refunds or credits.

# When is the last day to register?

- •Registration for camp weeks close three-weeks before the start of the week or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first.
- •Registration is first come, first serve.

# Do you offer discounts for summer?

•We do not offer discounts for siblings, but discounts are available for families who register early (see below).

### **Tuition and Cancellation Policies**

- 1) A \$25 registration fee (per camper) is required upon enrollment.
- 2) Payment is due at the time of enrollment via 1Core.
- 3) If you cancel prior to May 1, 2023, you will receive a refund of your payment to the original payment method, less a \$25 processing fee for each session you cancel. Cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on May 1, 2023.
- 4) If you cancel after May 1, 2023, you will receive a credit for each session you purchased, less a \$25 processing fee for each session you cancel, usable for any Rainbow Rising offering through August 16, 2024. A three-week notice is required for cancellation credit to be applicable to your account. Cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on the corresponding deadlines.
- 5) There will be no refunds, credits, discounts, or make-up days given for absences including COVID-related closures or absences.
- 6) A three-week notice must be given prior to the first day of your camp week for schedule changes and availability is not guaranteed for added sessions. Session registration closes three-weeks before the start of the week or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first.

# **Enrollment Policies**

- 1) Emergency information and medical release forms must be completed prior to your child's attendance.
- 2) Parents are responsible for reading all newsletters, signs, bulletins, and emails pertaining to our summer program.
- 3) Parents are responsible for packing their child a lunch each day unless otherwise specified. Please do not send anything that needs to be heated up or prepared.
- 4) On field trips/special event days, children must be at the center by the departure time listed. Children arriving after the listed departure time will not be allowed to participate in the excursion/special event and alternative care will not be available. Children may not stay at the center if they are scheduled to attend a special event/field trip.
- 5) Field trips/special events are a privilege at Rainbow, not a right. If any child cannot be safe or if they jeopardize the safety of other children during any field trip or activity, Rainbow reserves the right to take disciplinary action and/or exclude that child from excursions or activities.
- 6) Field trips/special events are subject to change. Please refer to your site's summer newsletters for more information. We reserve the right to cancel should we be unable to continue with an event due to COVID-19 and/or weather conditions.
- 7) Registration is based on availability and is not guaranteed. Registration closes three-weeks prior to the start of the session or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first.
- 8) The half day program hours are 10AM 3PM unless otherwise specified on an event or field trip day. Late pick-up fees will apply after 3PM and early drop-off fees will apply before 10AM.
- 9) At this time, we can not accept parent volunteers during the camp day or for field trips/special events.
