Why do the rates change each week?

- We're using dynamic pricing based on field trips, special events, and staffing needs for each week. This ensures we can provide high-quality experiences while maintaining fairness and sustainability for all families.

How do I pay for camp?

- We only accept online payments through 1Core. Payments are due at the time of registration.
- A 2.75% service fee is applicable for debit and credit card payments.
- A \$35 NSF fee will apply to all returned payments.

Are there refunds or credits given for absences?

- There will be no refunds, credits, discounts, or make-up days given for absences, days missed, or closures (including closures or absences due to Covid, absences due to illness/injuries, or time missed for behavior dismissals or suspensions).

What if I need to cancel or change my enrolled dates?

- For schedule changes/switches, a two-week written notice must be given prior to the first day of your camp week for schedule changes and availability is not guaranteed for added weeks. Weekly registration closes two weeks before the start of the week or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first.
- For cancellations, refund and credit eligibility is based on when you cancel relative to the affected camp week's start date. Please refer to the "Cancellation & Refund Policy" page for details.
- Cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on the corresponding deadlines - refer to the cancellation calendar for specific details.
- Registration fees are not eligible for refunds or credits.

When is the last day to register?

- Registration for camp weeks close two weeks before the start of the week or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first.
- Registration is first come, first serve.

Do you offer discounts for summer?

- We do not offer discounts for siblings, but a \$25 early bird discount is available for families who register by May 1st and a 5% discount for those paying for 3+ weeks in full by June 2.

Registration & Payment Policies:

1. A \$25 registration fee (per camper) is required upon enrollment.
2. Payment is due at the time of enrollment via 1Core. If you are in need of a weekly payment accommodation, please contact your Site Director.
3. There is a 2.75% processing fee collected by the processor for card payments (credit cards and debit cards). There is no processing fee for ACH payments set up directly with a routing and account number.
4. Parent/guardian(s) are responsible for ensuring that all account information is up to date monthly and that all ACH transactions are successfully withdrawn from their account. Returned payments are subject to a \$35 NSF fee.
5. There may be additional fees during camp for optional events. These fees may have different payment expectations and deadlines. Please refer to those policies in your site's weekly newsletter.
6. Registration for camp weeks close two weeks before the start of the week or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first. Registration is first come, first serve.
7. For any registration requests after the enrollment period closes, a \$25 late fee will be added in addition to the required registration fee and weekly fee(s). Late enrollment is not guaranteed and a waiting list may apply to certain days/events. In the event of a waiting list for a specific day or event, weekly fees will not be prorated if unable to attend.

General Enrollment Policies:

1. Minimum age/grade requirement: campers must be entering Kindergarten in fall 2025 in order to be eligible for camp.
2. Emergency information and medical release forms must be completed prior to your child's attendance.
3. Parents/guardians are responsible for reading all newsletters, signs, bulletins, and emails pertaining to our summer program.
4. Parents/guardians are responsible for packing their child a lunch each day unless otherwise specified. Please do not send anything that needs to be heated up or prepared.
5. On field trip/special event days, children must be at the center by the departure time listed. Children arriving after the listed departure time will not be allowed to participate in the field trip/special event and alternative care will not be available. All Rainbow Rising field trip participants must wear the Rainbow Rising t-shirt assigned to their age group in order to attend the field trip. Children may not stay at the center if they are scheduled to attend an off-site special event/field trip.
6. Field trips/special events are a privilege at Rainbow, not a right. If any child cannot be safe or if they jeopardize the safety of other children during any field trip or activity, Rainbow reserves the right to take disciplinary action and/or exclude that child from excursions or activities.
7. Field trip/special event days are subject to change and we reserve the right to cancel should we be unable to continue with an event for any reason. Please refer to your site's communication (emails, newsletters, flyers, etc.) for more information.
8. Registration is based on availability and is not guaranteed. Registration closes two weeks prior to the start of the week or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first.
9. The half day program hours are 10AM - 3PM unless otherwise specified on an event or field trip day. Late pick-up fees will apply after 3PM and early drop-off fees will apply before 10AM.
10. A \$20 late fee per child is charged for every fifteen minutes or portion thereof beginning at 6:01PM (full day), 3:01PM (half day). This \$20 fee also applies for every fifteen minutes or portion thereof if half day drop-off occurs prior to 10AM.
11. At this time, we can not accept parent volunteers during the camp day or for field trips/special events.



RAINBOW RISING SUMMER CAMP 2025 CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

We understand that summer plans can change. Our cancellation policy is designed to provide families with flexibility while ensuring we can plan effectively for staffing, field trips, and supplies.

1) Refund & Credit Deadlines by Camp Week:

Refund and credit eligibility is based on when you cancel relative to the affected camp week's start date:

- **Refunds are issued to the original payment method** and may take up to 21 business days to process.
- **Credits can be applied toward any Rainbow Rising program offering through August 14, 2026.**

2) Non-Refundable Registration Fee Policy:

To secure your camper's spot, a **\$25 non-refundable registration fee per camper** is required at registration. This is **not refundable under any circumstances** if you cancel your summer camp enrollment.

3) No Refunds, Credits, Discounts, or Make-Up Days for the Following:

- **No-shows** or last-minute withdrawals.
- **Missed days due to illness (including Covid), injuries, vacation, or personal scheduling conflicts.**
- **Behavior-related dismissals or suspensions** from camp.

4) How to Cancel & Request a Refund or Credit

Cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on the deadline date (refer to the cancellation calendar). **Requests received after the deadline will be processed based on the next refund tier.**

5) Additional Policies

A two-week notice must be given prior to the first day of your camp week for schedule changes and availability is not guaranteed for added weeks. Weekly registration closes two weeks before the start of the week or when capacity is reached, whichever occurs first.

Full Refund-Eligible Cancellation Policy:

If you cancel 6+ weeks in advance of the affected week's start date, you will receive a full refund of your payment to the original payment method, less a \$10 processing fee for each week you cancel (per camper). Registration fees are non-refundable.

To receive a full refund, cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on the six-week deadline(s) noted above. Cancellations made after the deadline will not be eligible for a full refund.

50% Refund-Eligible Cancellation Policy:

If you cancel 4-6 weeks in advance of the affected week's start date, you will receive a 50% refund of your payment to the original payment method, less a \$10 processing fee for each week you cancel (per camper). Registration fees are non-refundable.

Alternatively, you can choose to cancel for a full credit (minus the processing fee) usable for any Rainbow Rising offering through August 14, 2026. Please see credit-eligible policy below.

To be eligible for a 50% refund, cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on the four-week deadline(s) noted above. Cancellations made after the deadline will not qualify for a 50% refund.

Credit-Eligible Cancellation Policy:

If you cancel 2-4 weeks in advance of the affected week's start date, you will receive a credit for each week you purchased, less a \$10 processing fee for each week you cancel (per camper), usable for any Rainbow Rising offering through August 14, 2026. Registration fees are not eligible for credits. A minimum two-week notice is required for cancellation credit to be applicable to your account.

Cancellation requests must be emailed to your Site Director by 6PM on the corresponding deadlines above to be eligible for credit. No credits will be issued for cancellation requests after the deadlines.
